Please note also that we do not encourage any resident to keep more than \$2-\$3 on them. We offer a resident trust fund where the business office can keep available cash safe but accessible for them. This is the best practice!

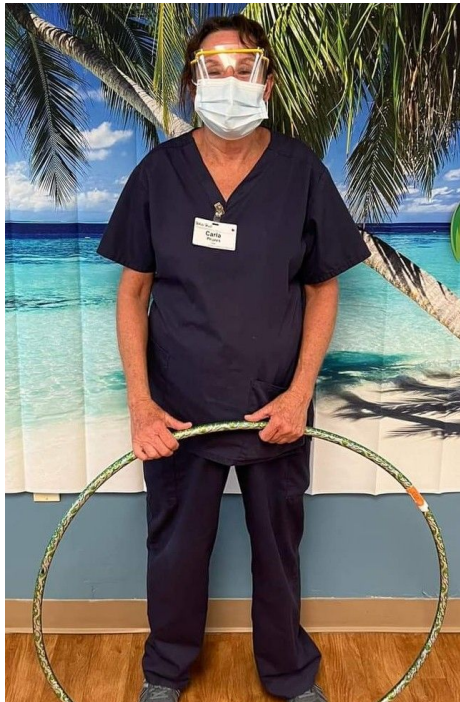


Celebrating Nurses & CNAs

Strawberry Poke Cake - A Light Summer Dessert



- 1 (15.25 oz) vanilla cake mix
- 1 (3oz) box strawberry jello
- 1 (21oz) can strawberry pie filling
- 1 (8oz) container whipped topping
- Fresh Strawberries for garnish

1. Prepare cake mix & bake as directed. Cool slightly (10-15 min). With the handle of a wooden spoon poke holes all over the cake (go to bottom of pan) so that the jello can seep in.
2. Make jello as directed on box-1 cup boiling water, mix till dissolved then add 1 cup cold water.
3. Pour jello mixture evenly over cake, filling all holes. Cover and refrigerate for 3-4 hours or overnight.
4. Spread pie filling evenly over cake & then top with whipped topping. Garnish with strawberries and enjoy.
